This international standard building consists of 17 stories, 2 levels of basement with GFA of approximately 42,152 sq.m.

Meinhardt is providing full C&S, MEP engineering design for this hospital to meet the JCI Accreditation Standards, AIA Space Standards and AHSRAE for HVAC Design.
