FACT IN FOCUS

Do you know that: In pursuing LEED Certification, apartments and condominiums are considered to be multifamily buildings. The entire building must register to participate; buildings cannot be partially certified and every unit within a multifamily building must earn the same certification level (e.g. Silver, Gold). A multifamily project can be certified under a different system depending on number of building floors.
