FACT IN FOCUS

Do you know that: PM2.5 stands for Particulate Matter 2.5 Microns? The 2.5-micron size range is the smallest range for measuring air pollution. These are ultrafine particles and is approximately 4% of the size of a human hair. To protect your lung, minimize the amount of time you spend outdoors or wear a face mask (rated at N95 or higher) if you have to. When indoor, ASHRAE Standard 62.1-2013 (Ventilation for Acceptable Indoor Air Quality) requires Minimum Efficiency Report Value (MERV) rated from MERV 1 to MERV 20 to be at MERV 8 air filters for cooling coils supplying occupied spaces; but for areas with PM2.5 levels exceeding the national (USA) standard, then minimum MERV 11 air filters are required.
