PROJECT IN FOCUS

The Embankment is located at 20 Kabar Aye Pagoda Road, Yangon by Four Rivers Inya Office Co. Ltd. This boutique steel frame office building design follows international standards with a planned CFA of 21,668 m2. and 12,567 m2. NLA. The building will comprise a 18-storey office tower, column free floor plates with 360 o Lake and City views, a 2 level basement car park with mechanical parking and a ground floor retail area.

Meinhardt is providing C&S, MEP Engineering Design, Specialist Lighting Design, Traffic Engineering and ESD services to the project.

The project will target multinational corporate clients and be comparable with **the highest quality buildings in the region**, and will be LEED Certified when completed in late 2020.
