Planning strategies, land use practices, and regulations are the top priorities to be considered when designing for large mixed-use development. Public Utilities capacity calculation, allocation and coordination with related authorities which include the Metropolitan Electricity Authority, Metropolitan Waterworks Authority and the Department of Drainage and Sewerage must be clarified and calculated accurately. This is to confirm that the available utility and infrastructure can support the development without disruption to other residents or neighboring properties.
