This month's feature project is **Nestle Korakot Project** which is a greenfield Pet Food Facility in Amata Rayong Industrial Estate, Rayong. The project consists of a Social Block, Utility Block, RM & PM Warehouse, Wet Process area, WIP, Packaging area, FG Warehouse and WWTP with a total GFA exceeding 23,000 sq.m. **Meinhardt is providing Basic Design, Detailed Design and Project & Construction Management services** for the project, including design coordination using BIM. The project team has just celebrated 2 million safe working hours with no lost-time injury last month.

With the latest cutting edge production equipment, the Korakot project is at its final commissioning stage for producing wet pet foods under the brand of Purina.
